



# GOLDEN GATE YACHT CLUB NOTICE OF RACE 2009 ISLANDER 36 NATIONAL REGATTA October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2009

# **Organizing Authority:** The Golden Gate Yacht Club, San Francisco, California **Rules:**

- This series of races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules f Sailing 2009-2012 including the Prescriptions of US Sailing, and the 2009 Islander 36 Nationals Sailing Instructions.
- Competitors shall wear PFD's while racing; the "Y" flag will not be displayed.

#### **Eligibility and Entry:**

- Any Islander 36 yacht in good standing with the I36 Association, and meeting the one design status of the fleet as determined by the fleet measurer, is eligible.
- Entry forms are available on the I36 website Nationals Regatta page: <u>www.islander36.org</u>
- There is no entry fee for the Regatta.

#### Schedule of Races:

- The warning signal is 12:00 hours.
- Two consecutive races are scheduled.
- Warning for subsequent races will be 10 minutes after the final boat has completed the previous race.
- A third race will be run if a tie-breaker is needed.

## **Racing Area and Courses:**

- The starting line will be the orange placard on the GGYC rae deck and Buoy X.
- Races will be sailed on City Front courses.
- If possible, one race will be a windward/leeward course and one race will include a reaching leg.

## Sailing Instructions:

- Copies will be available at the Golden Gate Yacht Club on September 29, 2009, as well as on both the GGYC website: www.ggyc.com and the Islander 36 website: www.islander36.org.
- Notices to competitors will be posted at the Golden Gate Yacht Club's official notice board located in the window on the west side of the interior entrance into the club.

**Scoring:** The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.

# Hospitality:

- Awards will be presented to first, second, and third place finishers. All boats will receive recognition for their participation in the regatta.
- The awards presentation will take place at GGYC once all boats have arrived.
- A no host bar and an appetizer buffet (\$15 20 per person, to be determined) will be available.
- All skippers, crew, family friends, and race supporters are encouraged to attend the awards presentation.
